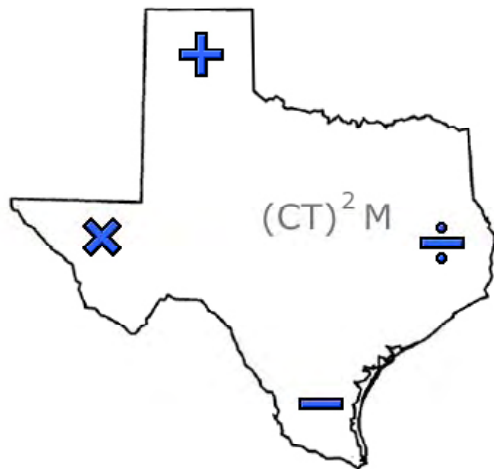

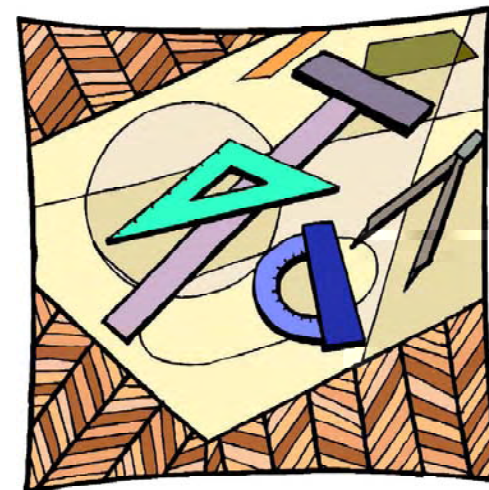

## Opening Session



The keynote speaker will be Jane Schielack, Professor of Mathematics at Texas A&M University. For the past 25 years, Jane has been involved in improving the mathematics content preparation of preservice and in-service teachers in Texas for grades PK-12. Her earlier experiences include work with TEA to develop the Essential Elements and later to aid in implementation of the TEKS. More recently, she chaired the writing group for NCTM's *Curriculum Focal Points for PK-8 Mathematics: A Quest for Coherence*.
