Who is a Master Math Teacher?

A Master Math Teacher is an individual who holds a Master Mathematics Teacher Certificate and whose primary duties are to teach math and to serve as a math mentor to other teachers.

Who can apply?

Applications will be reviewed by a screening committee. The application process is open to candidates who have the following:

- A minimum of **three years teaching experience**
- A valid **Texas Teaching Certificate**
- **Recommendations** from administrators and others knowledgeable about the candidate's potential to impact math achievement
- **Evidence of commitment** to the improvement of math education
- A strong **math background**
- Ability to work **collaboratively** with peers
- **Leadership** potential

Master Mathematics Teachers will be prepared to:



Mentor teachers through coaching, modeling research-based teaching techniques, and providing staff development.



Teach students with math deficiencies individually and in small groups, giving them the personal instruction and encouragement they need to succeed.



Guide districts through the transition to more rigorous state assessments.

What is the Cost?

The registration fee for the program is \$1200. In addition, textbooks will be required that cost up to an additional \$800.

Delivery Methods for the MMT Preparation Program include:

- Face-to-face meetings at ESC Region 12 in Waco or at an ESC Region 12 satellite location
- Online collaborative book studies through discussion forums
- Group projects
- Independent study components
- Distance Learning components
- A Lesson Study Cycle

2011 (Cycle 2) MMT Program Dates: Orientation June 10, 2011

June 16, 20-23, 29, 30, July 11-13, September 7, 21 October 14, 27, November 10, December 5

Selected candidates will be expected to complete **108 course hours** as well as a significant amount of outside work and must pass the TExMaT exam to become certified as a Master Math Teacher. The registration fee for the program is \$1200, with an additional cost of approximately \$800 for textbooks and supplies required for the course.

As per House Bill 2307, districts with "**high need**" campuses may apply to the Commissioner of Education for funds to provide **stipends** to Master Math Teachers. Additional information about the Master Math Teacher Certification Program is available on the TEA Web site at
