Expenditure Guide

The range of standard rates of care is determined by the intensity of student needs supported by documentation in each application and is not based solely on the maximum allowable expenditures. Standard rates may vary, however, effort should be made to keep total expenditure for each service, per application, within the maximum allowable amount.

Standard Rates of Care:

Allowable Expenditures*

Service Standard Rate Maximum Allowable**

Attendant Care* (*occasional- 3 hrs max. per 24 hours*) \$15.00-25.00 per hour

Psychiatric/Psychological Consultation \$75.00-125.00 session

Management of Leisure Time \$15.00-30.00 per hour

Socialization Training \$15.00-30.00 per hour

Individual Support \$15.00-30.00 per hour

Family Support \$15.00-30.00 per hour

Family Dynamics Training \$75.00 – 125.00 per hour

Transportation to access approved noned services


(*e.g., to psychiatric/psychological consult*) Use current district policy for transportation rates

Generalization Training \$30.00-60.00 per hour

Peer Support Group \$15.00-30.00 per hour

Parent Support Group \$15.00-30.00 per hour

UnAllowable Expenditures

All special education and related services allowable by IDEA in the implementation of a student's IEP (including adaptive equipment, art therapy, corrective therapy, music therapy, orientation and mobility training, school health services, recreation therapy) 

Babysitting (this includes attendant care when no family member is available or caring for a child while the parent is at work)

- Day/Night care exceeding 3 hours in a 24 hour period***
- Direct payment to parents***
- Equipment***
- Food***
- Medicine, medical prescriptions, doctor/dentist visits, medication therapy, evaluations***
- Remodeling/construction of the student's classroom and/or home***
- Sheltered workshop services***
- Transportation to any educational service or any service being provided by another public agency***

**Students with autism can only be approved for respite care or attendant care. In-home training or viable alternatives and parent training that support the student's individual educational plan must be paid with educational funds as required by 19 TAC §89.1055(e).*
