





Longitudinal Progress Monitoring

The same concept holds true for the Test, Cross-Test Scores and Total Score.






SAT College and Career Readiness Benchmarks

- Grade-level benchmarks are based on expected student growth toward the SAT Benchmarks:






Section Score Ranges – Example Math Section, 11th Graders



Concordance




Defining Concordance



The term **concordance** refers to linking scores on assessments that measure similar (but not identical) constructs and in which scores on any of the linked measures are used to make a particular decision.



Easily convert old SAT scores to new, and vice-versa.


Download the app by searching for SAT Score Converter on Google Play or the App Store.

Fee Waivers



SAT[®] Fee Waivers

Eligible students qualify for up to 4 fee waivers — 2 for the SAT and 2 for the SAT Subject Tests[™]. These students receive:

- 100% of the registration fees for a single test date (during regular or late registration).
- 4 additional score reports (worth a total of \$45) sent to the colleges of their choice at any time for free (regardless of how many fee waivers are used).
- Up to 4 requests to waive college application fees.
- Free access to the Question-and-Answer Service or the Student Answer Service when ordered during registration.
- Domestic students who used an SAT fee waiver while applying to college for the first time may also receive a CSS/Financial Aid PROFILE fee waiver.

About the SAT Fee-Waiver Service

As a not-for-profit membership organization, the College Board is committed to excellence and equity in education. Based on a growing body of research, we have broadened our efforts to help all students make the most of the opportunities they've earned. The distribution of fee waivers and related services to eligible, college-aspiring students sits at the heart of these efforts.

Improving Access to Higher Education

Thanks in large part to the passionate efforts of counselors and student advocates like you, the SAT® Fee-Waiver Service continues to reach record numbers of low-income students. Fee waivers offer a great opportunity for low-income students to show colleges that they are interested in pursuing higher education by taking the SAT or SAT SubjectTests". Counselors play an important role by encouraging students to show up on test day and follow through in applying to college. Here are a few effective strategies used by counselors:

- Distribute fee waivers to students who meet the eligibility requirements detailed in this brochure.
- Offer as much encouragement and support as you can to these students, who often face barriers to testing that more economically secure students may not encounter.
- Connect fee-waiver recipients to the full suite of free SAT and SAT Subject Test practice
 materials, so they can feel more confident and prepared as test day approaches.
- Provide reminders to plan transportation and other logistics.

The SAT Counselor Registration Report, available at sat.org/reg-roster, can help you identify students who need additional support. Use it to view and create customized reports that show which of your students are registered for the SAT and SAT Subject Tests. You can also track who used a fee waiver, who was absent on test day, and other useful information to help put students on the path to college. (The SAT Counselor Registration Report is only for use by authorized school personnel.)

Additional Resources to Support Career and College Readiness



PSAT/NMSQT Fee Waivers

- Fee waivers are for low-income 11th-graders taking the PSAT/NMSQT.
- Schools, not students, request fee waivers.
- Fee waivers might not be available after the June ordering deadline.
- There are no fee waivers for the PSAT 10 or PSAT 8/9.

SAT Fee Waivers

- SAT fee waivers are available to low-income 11th and 12th grade students
- SAT Subject Test fee waivers to students in 9th-12th grade

SAT Fee Waivers Cover:

- The registration fee for up to two SATs, with or without the SAT Essay
- The registration fee for up to two SAT Subject Test administrations
- Four limited-time score reports plus four to use at any time (see details below)
- Four college application fee waivers
- Question-and-Answer Service (QAS) or Student Answer Service (SAS) if ordered at the time of registration
- A fee reduction for multiple-choice score verification or essay score verification

AP Fee Reductions

2016 AP Exam Fee: \$92

- The College Board provides a \$30 fee reduction per exam for students with financial need.
- For each AP Exam taken with a fee reduction, the school forgoes its \$9 rebate
- TEA provided a \$46 per exam for students who qualify for a fee reduction*.

TOTAL COST TO STUDENT: \$7.00

*There are different fees and reductions for AP Capstone Courses


PSAT/NMSQT and SAT Fee Waiver and AP Fee Reduction Eligibility

• Eleventh-graders who qualify for or are enrolled in the NSLP are eligible. Students in areas covered by the Community Eligibility Provision must qualify on an individual basis.

Alternative Eligibility

Eleventh-graders qualify for fee waivers if any of the following statements is true:

- Their family's annual income falls within the Income Eligibility Guidelines set by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food and Nutrition Service._
- They're enrolled in a federal, state, or local program that aids students from low-income families (e.g., TRIO programs such as Upward Bound).
- Their family receives public assistance.
- They're homeless, live in federally subsidized public housing, or a foster home.
- They're a ward of the state or an orphan.






