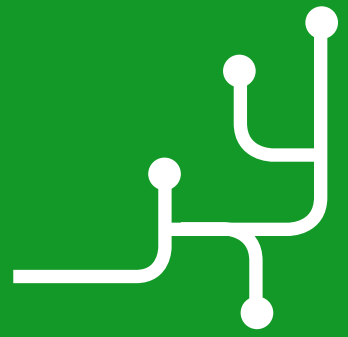

The ESC Region 12 Technology Foundation was established in 2012 and is dedicated **to providing additional resources to Central Texas schools for technology programs.** Grant funds are restricted to the purchase of state-of-the-art equipment and/or programs that **enhance learning** through the **integration of technology** in the classroom. The Foundation is deeply committed to supporting the education of all students in Region 12, which includes 76 school districts and charter schools in 12 counties.

The purpose of the Foundation is to generate, manage and distribute funds for technology programs not funded by tax dollars. Funding to schools is supplemental and does not replace or alter their use of tax-based revenue.
