Collectively, these schools represent 1,327 students across four counties and six districts. The grant funds will be used to purchase state-of-the-art equipment such as ENO White Boards, Chromebooks and iPads to support traditional classroom learning, enabling both enrichment and remediation across all curriculum areas including literacy, writing, research, science and math.
