

The Migrant Shared Services Arrangement (SSA) provides districts with direct services required under the Every Child Succeeds Act Title I, Part C (Migrant Education Program) for migrant students and families.



SSA Benefits

In addition to all general Migrant Support Services, the SSA also includes:

- Completion of the ESSA Consolidated Application for Funding
- Completion and submission of the ESSA Compliance Report

General Support Services

- No-cost professional development
- An assigned Migrant Service Coordinator (MSC)
- Training for MSC and migrant program personnel
- Assistance in the identification and recruitment of migrant students
- Migrant student data entry services through the New Generation System (NGS)
- Migrant Parent Advisory Council
- Priority for Service instructor to work one-on-one with campus administrators and teachers
- Assistance in meeting state and federal requirements
- Counseling services provided by ESC Region 12 to migrant students to assist with graduation plans, credit accrual and accessing financial aid
